

**WIBSEY PRIMARY SCHOOL,  
NORTH ROAD, WIBSEY,  
BRADFORD,  
BD61RL**

(Group 4)

**Wibsey Primary School** is situated in the centre of Wibsey village on the outskirts of Bradford. It is a three form entry primary school + 78 part-time nursery children.

The school has a mixed catchment area drawing children from the local council estate and also from private housing.

Wibsey is a split site school. The large Victorian main building, consisting of 21 classrooms, computer suite + 3 satellite suites, 2 halls, library, and the canteen, is on one side of a road.

The headteacher's and administration offices and staffroom are also in this building. The Foundation Unit (Reception and Nursery) is self-contained in modern purpose built buildings on the other side.

The main school has a large hard play area for breaks and outdoor PE sessions which is marked out for Zoneparc activities.

**The school is a no smoking site.**

The children are taught in 21 mixed ability classes, three classes per year group, for all subjects except literacy and numeracy for which there are setting arrangements in Years 4 - 6.

Children are admitted into Reception at the beginning of the school year in which they are five.

Current staffing levels are Head + 29 teachers. There are 6 Cover Supervisors, 30 Teaching Assistants, Bursar and 4 administration staff.

The majority of children transfer from our Nursery into school at the beginning of the school year in which they are five although some children leave to attend other primary schools in the area.

At eleven years of age the children transfer to a variety of the recently reorganised secondary schools.
